

Once again on The Solemnity of Christ the King, November 24th, a Eucharistic Procession is being organized to take place here in the cluster (Transfiguration Church and Our Lady of Grace Church). There was wonderful participation from both parishes, and we are praying that the response this year is even greater. Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will take place at Transfiguration Church at 2:00 PM followed by The Procession with the Blessed Sacrament down Castro Valley Blvd to Our Lady of Grace Church.

Everyone is encouraged to come and be a part of the process because as the Eucharist is carried through our streets, we give a public witness to our faith, and we show to others along the way our devotion towards the sacrament. Proclaim God's Word and Deepen Your Faith

Many years ago people told me I had a voice (and maybe a face?) for radio. However, my discomfort with public speaking discouraged me from volunteering to be a Lector. It wasn't until I served on Cursillo teams where I was asked to read scripture at some of the meetings, and then became more comfortable doing so. After proclaiming at weekday masses for about a year, Barb Mehan "drafted" me (basically signed me up) to proclaim at weekend masses also.

For any ceremony or event, a person becomes more engaged if they are part of the ceremony. In preparing to proclaim at mass, practicing the reading beforehand results in a deeper understanding of its content, and in many cases, raises questions to ponder about what the reading says to me and the congregation. Often there is a common thread or message among the readings that becomes more apparent when doing my preparation. Overall, my understanding of the bible, God's Word and our faith has deepened, and is still deepening, as a result of proclaiming his Word at Mass.
