



The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA) provides a vision of the community walking with one another and with God. In this way those in the process are invited to lead a life worthy of a disciple of Christ. The OCIA is a time of evangelization. This is an apprenticeship in the Catholic way of life. As the initiation process continues, those involved in the program have their relationship with the Lord strengthened preparing them to receive the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation. Then, following the reception of the Sacraments of Initiation, those who have entered into full membership in the Catholic Church are given the opportunity to integrate what they have learned about our faith in their daily lives. be incorporated into life as a fully initiated Catholic. 
