

#### **August 24, 2025** 21st Sunday in Ordinary Time Luke 13:22-30

I've been hiking Camelback Mountain in Phoenix, Arizona most of my life. It is a vigorous forty-five minutes to the top. Near the peak, the end suddenly appears much further away, and steeper. At that moment, a descending hiker often offers encouragement: "Keep going! The peak is right there. It's not as far as it looks. You can do it!" It usually works. After another five minute push, you summit and enjoy a glorious panorama of the Sonoran Desert in the Valley of the Sun.

When Jesus is asked about how many people are saved, he says: "Strive to enter through the narrow gate" (Luke 13:24). How many? Strive! Focus on your journey. What does heavenly census taking have to do with you or me? How would it help a hiker on a mountain to ask the others coming down, "How many people are going to make it to the top?" A normal response would be something like: "How is that a relevant question? Carry on!"

Jesus links one virtue directly to salvation: perseverance (cf. Matt 24:13; hypomone in Greek). Strive! Endure! Keep going! The one absolutely necessary virtue is perseverance, to not give up on our journey. The mountain we struggle to climb is often our own weakness, failures, and sins. Persevere in prayer. Keep celebrating the sacraments. Embrace daily duties. With God's grace, you are strong enough to keep going. Perhaps the peak is not as far away as you might fear. Keep going!

My brothers and sisters in the Lord,



It's always good to reflect upon the Blessed Virgin Mary and the many Liturgical Celebrations in her honor. Today, I would like to bring to everyone's attention The Queenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This special title given to the Blessed Virgin Mary was recognized this past Friday, August 22nd.

The Queenship of Mary has deep roots in our Catholic Faith and Tradition. It is celebrated in relation to the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, as we all know, is celebrated as a Holy Day of Obligation on August 15th . Having just celebrated the Assumption followed by The Queenship of Mary, the Church emphasizes the special place that Mary has in heaven as Queen of Heaven and Earth.

Since Jesus is the King of Kings and Lord of Lords seated on His throne at the right hand of the Father in Heaven, and since his mother was assumed into Heaven, body and soul, The Queenship of Mary follows naturally. It celebrates the fact that, in Heaven, Jesus' mother is seated on a throne next to Her Son. The Queenship of Mary was first celebrated on May 31st, which naturally followed the celebration of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. It was only in 1969 that this celebration was moved to August 22nd, eight days after the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary so that an octave (8 days) would be created and there would be a natural progression from the Assumption to the Queenship of Mary. As Queen and Mother, Mary intercedes for us to her Son. As intercessor, from her throne in heaven nothing pleases her more than to pour out upon us every good thing so that one day we can all be together in heaven.

My friends, we not only have a Mother in heaven, but we have a Queen Mother. With Mary as the Queen Mother of God and our mother, let's turn to her with childlike faith and simplicity. Let us approach Mary, our Mother. Let us recognize Mary as our protectress, our refuge, and our hope. Let's thank God for the gift of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of Jesus and our Mother today and always.




